Civil War enlistment

Iowa Volunteers First Battery Light Artillery, enlisted Oct. 22, 1861, Discharged June 3 1862. Residence at enlistment was Monmouth, Illinois.

This battery was raised in July and Aug. 1861, at Burlington, Iowa and remained in that city until The December following, when it was ordered to Benton barracks, St. Louis, Missouri. Andrew Lyons became ill from a protracted illness and was in the hospital in St. Louis from Jan. to May 1862.

Joined as a recruit Oct 22, 1861. Discharged June 3, 1862 by special order 217, Department of Mississippi by reason of protracted illness and absence.

Andrew Lyons was on the Illinois U.S. Civil War Draft Registration records dated July 1, 1863. He is listed with other civil war veterans. His address is Coldbrook township, Warren county, Illinois - Lyons, Andrew 21 white farmer, former military service - unspecified.
